5. Membership Report, Tina Schulz

- e. 2018-19 prices remain the same
 - i. Six home football games for the 2018-19 season. This is one additional to last year.

6. Operations Report, Carylin Waterval

- a. Toy Soldier Event: September 7-8
 - i. Frankie is helping Carylin with this event
 - ii. Future rates may need to change due to their space requirements.
 - iii. Set up/tear-down times are: Friday evening 4-6pm– Saturday afternoon slots 7-9am and 3:30 – 5:30pm
 - 1. \$200 allocated per team, per slot.
 - iv. Recommend that all teams have an equal opportunity to work.
 - 1. Teams need to indicate interest – if multiple teams are interested, there will be a drawing for the assignments.
 - 2. Only one team per slot, unless not enough teams are available to fill all slots.
- b. Craft fair: November 10
 - i. Vendor sign ups will be sent next week.
 - ii. Survey results will be used to confirm hours of operations and other process changes.
 - iii. Myleen will create SUG for this event.

 - ii. Shortly after RFP was released, the county contacted Greg Dombrowski and Jennifer Jarmin to inform them that Boosters couldn't manage this project as outlined in the RFP.
 - iii. Our efforts were halted and are awaiting county assessment on the dugout conditions.
 - iv. A meeting has taken place with county representative and Ms. Brumfeld, but no information has been shared.
 - v. Jennifer has emailed county representative for status update, but has received no response.
 1. She will write to Tammy Kaufax (school board member, Edison Parent alumni) and Kevin Sneed (county representative) for status update.

9. New Business

- a. Kristyna passed around pictures of new spirit wear.
 - i. Karen Krotine is the Spirit wear chair
- b. Small banner signs (hung at football stadium):
 - i. Kristyna will reach to previous banner buyers - \$10 to renew.
 1. Renewals have to be confirmed by first home football game.
