- 3. Bingo
 - **a.** There is a large value disparity of the Bingo prize baskets.
 - i. Some baskets have a really high value.
 - **ii.** The high value of the baskets doesn't bring more people to the event.
 - iii. Perhaps make a bigger effort to tier the baskets.

 - v. There were numerous baskets too many to be awarded for the games many were transitioned to raffle prizes.
