**President's Report/Carylin Waterval:** Introductions. We are looking for new board members. We will be sending updates in the Eagle Blast and News you Choose. Every year has been a little interesting since COVID. We have struggled to get volunteers for concessions. Concessions is one of our largest fundraisers. We did discuss in Executive Session if we would be having a tag day where we canvass the neighborhood but we are pivoting to do a virtual fundraiser for the teams. It is a pretty big event that we feel we need more time to execute.

**DSA Report/Greg Dombroski:** Greg took a moment to congratulate our winter programs. Girls Basketball, Wrestling, Swim and Dive, Gymnastics, Winter Track all had a Rock Star Winter. We did lose the ability to have fans for about a month but we are hosting 2 double headers and Girls Championship game. If we win we would host again. 5:30 and 7:30 for double headers. Spring tryouts starting on Feb 21<sup>st</sup>. Praying for great weather. County will no longer be doing COVID testing of athletes. Masks will not be required outside. If they are inside they will be required. There is a meeting on the 23<sup>rd</sup> with nearby counties to see if other counties will be requiring masks. Arlington County is the only one we are waiting for a firm answer on. Shelly N. asked when water will be turned on outside. Greg says we are allowed to turn the water on March 14<sup>th</sup>. We can sign something that gives us permission to turn the water on earlier at our risk. That date would be March 1<sup>st</sup>. Still renovating baseball and softball fields. Waiting to get the trucks out there. The work was postponed from the wet weather. They are going to do 6 inches of sod to repair our fields instead of the couple of inches they usually do (for the same price). Liz S. asked if the fields would be ready for tryouts. Greg thinks not, but does feel it will be ready for the first game. We negotiated with Game Day to get the 6 inch sod because of the delay.

**Treasurer's Report/Carol Montoya:** We are little ahead on our balance sheet. Last year we had no concessions and this year we have had them so we are doing better than 2021 and getting closer to where we were in 2019. Carol pointed out the funds available for each team. Tracking well with our budget. Exceeded membership and we still received a 3,000 donation from Christmas Tree vendor, Kenny Roher. We are ahead on Spirit Wear sales. Brendan asked about the &Pizza Fundraiser check.

We want to let the coaches know their team balances so when we do raise money the teams benefit. We host one Wed track meet per season. Concessions will be staffed by track parents. Boosters would purchase the supplies.
