REGISTER PROMPTLY

Online registration is now open! PLEASE register before Friday, October 24, 2025 as this will allow us to efficiently plan out the vendor spaces within the school. Visit our online application form to apply now: https://fs4.formsite.com/ThomasEdisonHS/rzxle34flh/index

To register, complete all of the sections in the application <u>AND</u> submit payment. Applications are not final until payment is also received. Please note that all applications are subject to review/approval. If, for some reason, we do not approve your application, your payment will be refunded in full.

NON-HANDMADE/DIRECT SELLERS ITEMS MESSAGE

As we want this event to be as successful and fun for you, our visitors and us, the committee desires to have a variety of crafters in attendance. Because of this, we are only permitting ONE vendor representing a specific company to purchase a space. Ex. ONE Tupperware, ONE Thirty-One, etc. To prevent overlap, if this category applies to what you will be offering/selling, **PRIOR to submitting your application and submitting your payment**, you must contact: **CraftFair@edisonboosters.org**. Once we review your request, we will confirm via email the status and if approved, will request that you complete the application and payment process within 48 hours. If you do not register and pay within the prescribed time frame, you will forfeit your "spot" in line and you may be replaced with a similar vendor. Thank you for understanding.

CRAFT ITEM LISTING

Once you submit your application stating the items you want to sell, NO new items may be displayed or introduced. Also, when listing your items, please be general in your description. Ex. Handmade jewelry, custom coffee mugs, embroidered face masks, aromatherapy candles, etc. If your items are not HANDMADE by you, you must state so.

VENDOR SPACE DETAILS

The Fall Craft Fair will be held <u>indoors</u> in the cafeteria and gymnasium at the Thomas A. Edison High School in Alexandria, VA. All of our vendor spaces will be 10'x10'. You can rent (1) table (each table comes with 2 chairs) for \$10.00 each and will be distributed on a first come-first served basis via requests on the vendor application. There is no discount if you don't need the chairs with the table. Tables vary between 5'-6' – we can't guarantee size. Please note, due to the number of expected registrants, we cannot guarantee special requests such as being beside a friend. Also, electricity is

extremely limited in the cafeteria and gym area and will be available for a \$10.00 fee. We kindly ask that you ONLY request electricity if it is critical to your success that day. Please be sure to notate this area on your application and explain what you will be plugging into (glue gun, register, lights, etc.). Letting us know will allow us to strategically place our vendors to prevent circuit overload. If you need electricity, you will need to supply your own extension cord (25' or more) and tape to fully and safely hide and secure the cord in a safe manner for all. If your electricity request is not approved or if we run out of outlets, you will be refunded your \$10.00 in full.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Although there are many ancillary costs involved with an event like this, we will NOT be charging our visitors an admission fee to attend the event. As we get closer to the event, we will be sending out maps, parking information and last-minute reminders/details for you. In addition to all the great craft items you are displaying, we are planning to have some of Edison's school groups offering food and other goodies for our vendors and visitors to purchase. Back by popular demand, we have arranged to have a setup time from 7:00 pm – 9:00 pm on Friday, November 7 (and will open the doors Saturday morning at 7:30 am to give you additional time to organize your space. We will also have student/parent volunteers on hand to help you unload your vehicles and transport your items to your vendor location.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Once Edison Fall Craft Fair committee has accepted your application and vendor fee, NO REFUNDS will be given (NO exceptions, except those noted previously). If you are a direct seller or similar, please review the above notes on when to submit your application for review/approval.

If FCPS cancels the event or closes the school grounds, vendors can choose to apply their application fees toward the rescheduled Edison Fall Craft Fair event at a future date.

CRAFT FAIR RULES

 As stated previously, once we have accepted your application and vendor fee, no refunds will be given (NO exceptions, except those noted previously). If you are a direct seller or similar, please review the above notes on when to submit your application for review/ approval.

- Displays must be kept within the boundaries of your space assignment.
- Vendors can only display and sell the merchandise they stated on their application.
- Vendors must be at their assigned spaces by 9:00 am on Saturday, November 8 ready to greet our visitors.
- Vendor tables must be manned, and all displays visible from 9:00 am 3:00 pm. If you
 need to use the restroom or grab lunch, we can have a student volunteer watch over your
 table for you.
- Vendors MAY NOT remove displays or break down their tables prior to 3:00 pm.
- All displays and items must be taken down and removed immediately following the close of the event at 3:00 pm and vendors are responsible for cleaning their space before leaving.
- You are responsible for your products at all times including, but not limited to table coverings, pricing, receipts, bags, etc.
- All sales from our Edison Fall Craft Fair will be conducted between you/the vendor and the
 purchaser. Vendors are responsible for collecting, paying, and remitting any applicable Virginia
 Sales Tax to the Virginia Department of Taxation on all sales made during the Edison Fall
 Craft Fair.

VENDOR AGREEMENT

By completing and submitting our Edison Fall Craft Fair application for Saturday, November 8, 2025, vendors acknowledge they have read and understand this information packet and the rules and guidelines set forth above and agree to abide by them. The vendors and any "helpers" and/or assistants release Thomas A.
